

Guidelines for ESMTB Financial Support to Travel to Mathematical/Theoretical Biology Meetings 2009

- Applicants must be members of the ESMTB at the time funds are requested. Equal opportunity will be afforded all members. Preference will be given to applicants who have been members of the ESMTB for at least a year preceding the time of application, or whose advisors have been members for at least a year.
- Preference will be given to graduate students. But application is also possible for post-docs, senior scientists with insufficient travel funds, and non-ESMTB members who join at the time of application.
- Applicants have to present a paper or poster at the meeting.
- Preference will be given to individuals who did not receive a travel grant from the ESMTB before.
- Funding in most cases will be partial, limited to EUR 500, in order to support a greater number of attendees.

How to Apply: **Application Deadline for 2009: [June 30, 2009](#)**

Materials to be submitted:

1. Your name, institution, address and e-mail address, source of your monthly income.
2. Affirmation that you are a graduate student pursuing a degree in a field relevant to the meeting and the society. (This is to be verified by the letter from your advisor (see #6 below). Explanation why your presentation is important for the field of mathematical/theoretical biology.
3. Date you joined the ESMTB.
4. A copy of your CV.
5. Name of the advisor who will be supporting your application.
6. Recommendation for support funds from your research advisor stating why attendance at meeting will contribute to your development and to your research and indicating what other support is available. This can be sent separately from the student's application.
7. An outline of your financial needs in EUR. Indicate other support.
8. Title and abstract of your presentation.
